Requesting multiple emergency contacts upon enrollment to ensure students are released to safe homes Following an emergency management plan to determine a safe location for children to wait until an appropriate adult caregiver arrives
immigration enforcement policy calls for investigators to avoid using schools and other sensitive locations for enforcement activities, including interviews.
about the documentation required to enroll, but the AISD will not deny a child enrollment solely for failure to provide documentation proving identity or previous school records. In some instances, it is the school district's obligation to notify law enforcement of the discrepancy in case the student has been reported missing.
Upon enrollment, students will be given access to all relevant educational programs and services, including English language learner programs, special education services, free and reduced price lunch, and more.
