WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Arlington Independent School District (the "District") deems it advisable to call the Voter Approval Tax Rate special election hereinafter ordered; and

Revising the ad valorem tax rate of \$1.2871 in Arlington Independent School District for

the current year, a rate that will result in an increase of 12.42 percent in maintenance and operations tax revenue for the district for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$35,901,060.
