# Leaf Crayon Rubbing



Place your leaf under paper (printing paper works best) with the veins of the leaf facing up. Grab a crayon, lay it flat and rub the crayon over the leaf. If the rubbing doesn't show up, use more pressure, or try a darker crayon. Some leaves have better veins than others.
